

**Written responses from UN-Habitat to questions raised by Member States during the Executive Director's Donors Briefing on UN-Habitat's Covid-19 Response Plan**

**Monday 4 May 2020 – 16:00 – 17:00, East Africa Time**

**Question 1:** Please provide the breakdown of financial support received so far by UN-Habitat, following the launch of the Covid-19 Response Plan, detailed by country and by purpose.

**UN-Habitat's response to question 1 :**

- a) Alwaleed Philanthropies has provided USD 2,000,000 to establish temporary shelters and hand washing facilities in Iraq, Morocco, Syria, Tunisia and the West Bank.
- b) As part of the United Nations Global Humanitarian Response Plan, UN-Habitat has been allocated USD 50,000 for Support to Syrian refugees in Lebanon to provide immediate and emergency support mainly on WASH facilities

**Question 2:** Please provide the list of countries where emergency support is being provided with the USD 1.3 million provided by UN-Habitat.
